An average of 36 people take their own lives in Leon County every year – twice as many as those who die by homicide and even more than those who die from breast cancer.

For over 20 years, NAMI Tallahassee (the local affiliate of the National Alliance on Mental Illness) has supported families and their loved ones who are living with mental health issues. We are an all-volunteer non-profit organization. Our internationally respected signature programs have been at the root of our mission to educate, support, and advocate for everyone who is faced with this challenge. Embedded in all of our programs is the drive to save lives and improve outcomes.

In 2015 NAMI Tallahassee hosted the inaugural Bluebird Run for Brookie B honoring Brook Bowers who died by suicide in 2012. The Bluebird Run began to bring the issue of suicide out of the shadows and into the sunshine. Ever since, the community conversation surrounding suicide loss, prevention, intervention, and postvention has grown stronger.
